

The Church of the Covenants was built in 1923 as a Methodist church. It was empty for a while before it was used as a recreation center during WWII for the Navy recruits from Great Lakes Naval Base. The congregation purchased the building in 1947. The original organ was a 1923 Hinners which sat in front on the altar. The 2 manuals consisted of 11 ranks and 12 stops in the chambers in front, 4 ranks in the Great, 6 in the Swell, and 2 16's in the Pedal. The Church of the Covenants purchased the 1922 E. M. Skinner in 2009 from a Baptist church in Lewiston Maine. It was completely rebuilt by Bradford Organ Company and dedicated in 2010.
